## Financial Update - Moving in the Right Direction

As an independent church, not affiliated with any denomination, UUC is funded entirely by individual members and donors. We need a steady stream of financial support and volunteers to enable us to pay salaries and utilities and to help maintain our facilities and programs. Our operating budget-operating income gap narrowed more in December than initially reported. We had additional donations after Sunday December 29 received by mail that narrowed the gap to 17%. (Down from 29% on November 30.)

Income through December 31: \$82,961

Income needed through December 31 to make budget: \$99,875


